Matthew 25 at St. Vladimir Church encompasses many efforts including:

Meals at <u>Alpha House</u>, Food donations to <u>Food Gathers</u>, Cash Donations to <u>Davydova & IOCC</u>, providing basic supplies (socks, soap ...) for Shelter Association of Washtenaw County (<u>SAWC</u>), <u>School kits</u> for the needy around the world, Sunday Meals @ <u>Orthodox Detroit Outreach</u> (ODO), and working with <u>Holy Trinity Church</u> in Detroit.

To the Rescue is not an organization nor a committee but a collaboration between Holy Trinity § st. Vladimir Churches working with private donors to help the needy in Detroit. The focus is in 2 areas that are not well served by traditional, large charities:

- Helping those who have stumbled and need to get back on their feet
- Supporting <u>emergencies</u>



## Back on your Feet

This gentleman became homeless after losing his job as a dishwasher because of the pandemic. To the Rescue coordinated help for him! Private individuals found him a job, apartment & clothes. We supplied 3 months rent and furnished the apartment from plates to pillow cases. **He is now doing great!** 

Emergencies Fire destroyed the second floor of this house and all the the contents of bedrooms. Τo the Rescue got the family into a hotel for a week replaced beds, and linens and dressers.
