

Church School report 2026

Church School goal: Provide the knowledge and foundation of the Christian life and teach children Orthodox life skills to prepare them to serve God in Orthodox Christian communities in the future.

Objectives:

1. Instructing children in the foundation of Orthodox faith at the Church School classes every Saturday.
