Mission Statement

The mission of Ann Arbor Orthodox Classical Academy (A2OCA) is to provide a classical education in an Orthodox Christian environment, in which we actively practice our faith, allowing students to grow to their full human and spiritual potential, with the ability to engage society as mature followers of Jesus Christ.

Classes and Tuition

The in-person Microschooling Program is offered for Junior Kindergarten, Kindergarten, and 1st Grade students. While parent involvement/participation is encouraged, it is not a requirement for enrollment. Current tuition is as shown below. Not included in tuition is the cost of curriculum materials that parents are asked to purchase directly from the supplier (as itemized below according to grade level). Tuition discounts are available for multiple children enrolled from the same family; for more information, see the Tuition Contract document. We are committed to offering an education that is financially accessible to all families who wish to make A2OCA a part of their and their children's lives. If you require tuition assistance, please reach out to us to let us know, so that we can inform you of next steps. Classes begin September 19, 2022, and conclude no later than June 23, 2023, unless otherwise communicated by the Head of School. Kindly note that while in-person instruction is limited to the days and times noted below (in Eastern Standard Time; EST), students are regularly assigned homework and parents are expected to support students' engagement with homework, as well as teach other topics not covered in class, so that students may work steadily towards attaining their learning goals.

If you have chosen the trimester payment plan or the monthly payment plan, to secure your child(ren)'s enrollment, the tuition deposit (as indicated in the 'Tuition Contract') is due by the start of classes (unless prior arrangements have been made with the Head of School). Please e-mail us to let us know when the check is in the mail so that we may note this information accordingly on your account. The tuition deposit is non-refundable. If at any point you experience difficulty making a tuition payment, please reach out to us as soon as you are able to, so that we can work together to find a solution.

Additional Costs

Tuition Fees do not include the cost of consumable curriculum materials. Parents/guardians are responsible for purchasing these as soon as they are able to, directly from the supplier (i.e., Memoria Press and Orthodox Christian Education Commission), and instructors will provide students with any necessary learning materials until they receive their books.

Program Withdrawal

If you wish to withdraw your child(ren) from A2OCA's microschooling program, we ask that you submit your request in writing to Irene Melabiotis, Head of School (Interim), at <u>imelabiotis@a2oca.org</u>. Please provide sixty (60) days' notice. Please note that tuition payments due during the 60-day notice period will be billed to the family account; if this amount has been paid in advance, it is non-refundable, and if it has not been paid in advance, it is due before the child's last day with A2OCA. Kindly note that curriculum materials are non-refundable.

Statement of Inclusion

Ann Arbor Orthodox Classical Academy admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at A2OCA. Due to staffing, funding, and other limitations, A2OCA may not be in the position to adequately provide the necessary learning supports to some students with special learning needs.

Applications are considered complete when submitted with supporting documentation (as outlined in the 'Supporting Documentation' section) and when all sections are filled in appropriately. Please indicate a 'N/A' for sections that do not apply to your situation. Kindly ensure your application is complete and accurate prior to its submission. Upon your child's admission to A2OCA, you will be notified if there are any additional forms that need to be completed and submitted.
