Welcome to Ann Arbor Orthodox Classical Academy!

As we await the completion of our school building, we have transitioned to online instruction for the 2021-2022 school year. What classes are offered? When are they offered? How much is tuition?

Our online education program will take place on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays throughout the 2021-2022 school year (October 4, 2021, to June 23, 2022, unless otherwise noted) and will include instruction in Language Arts, Nature Studies (Science), and Math. Catechism class will take place on Wednesdays (more information is included below). While attendance at Divine Liturgy on Catechism days is strongly encouraged, attendance at some Divine Liturgies may be required to facilitate delivery of the Catechism lesson, and parents will be notified in advance if this is the case. **Kindly note that parents are responsible for purchasing the necessary student books** (i.e., consumable materials) directly from the supplier, with which students will engage for homework and extended learning opportunities at home.

CLASS 1: Kindergarten

* Parents/Guardians are required to be near their children during class times to assist with technical support throughout the lesson.

\$1215 per year, per student; select between full payment plan, trimester payment plan, or monthly payment plan (more information on each plan can be found in the Tuition Contract document)

\$1395 per year, per student; select between full payment plan, trimester payment plan, or monthly payment plan (more information on each plan can be found in the Tuition Contract document)

Are there any tuition discounts?

Yes! We offer tuition discounts for those wishing to pay in full prior to the start of classes, as noted under each class description above. We, also, offer tuition discounts for multiple children enrolled from the same family. For more information, see the Tuition Contract document. Is there anything else I should know?

We are so happy you have chosen to be a part of the Ann Arbor Orthodox Classical Academy (or 'A2OCA') family! This is an exciting time for both your family and for us, and we promise to do our best to support you and your child(ren) as you engage with our online learning program. Your child will be one of only 10-15 students in his or her class. We find smaller classes can help facilitate student learning, especially in the online learning environment.

As soon as you register we ask that you purchase the required consumable materials directly from Memoria Press (see appropriate grade-level links above), as well as the consumable materials for Catechism class directly from the Orthodox Christian Education Commission (see links above). For the first couple of weeks as you and your child settle into the online learning program and await your child's books to arrive, your child's instructor will provide the necessary learning materials, some of which may need to be printed off at home. Throughout the school year, your child's instructor may, also, send other materials to be printed off at home to facilitate their learning. For this reason, it is important to have a working printer at home.

We respect parents' role as their children's first educators. This online learning program is meant to support parents' efforts to provide a cognitively-stimulating, at-home education for their children within the classical education tradition. To meet this goal, throughout the school year the instructor will offer parents extended learning opportunities that their children can engage with at home to further explore a concept introduced in class. We encourage parents to facilitate their children's extended learning at home by regularly communicating these opportunities to their children and encouraging and supporting their engagement with them.
